

## DISMISSAL EFFECTIVE 1/1/08

- ❖ **Driving with Expired Driver's License (NOT APPLICABLE TO CDL)** – Defendant remedies the defect not later than the 20<sup>th</sup> working day after the date of the offense OR before the defendant's first court appearance date, whichever is later. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$20.00 dismissal fee. **\*\* HAS NOT BEEN EXPIRED FOR MORE THAN 60 DAYS.**
- ❖ **License to be Carried and Exhibited on Demand** – Defendant shows that a driver's license was issued to defendant and is appropriate for the vehicle driven and the was valid at the time of the offense the Court **SHALL** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee. **\*\*NO FEE CHARGED FOR CDL.**
- ❖ **Imposition of Special Restriction or Endorsement on Driver License** – The restriction or endorsement was imposed because of a physical condition that was surgically or otherwise medically corrected before the date of the offense OR in error and that fact is established by the defendant. The Defendant has the department remove the restriction or endorsement before the defendant's first appearance date. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Giving Notice of Change of Address or Name on Driver's License (NOT APPLICABLE TO CDL)** – Defendant remedies the defect not later than the 20<sup>th</sup> working day after the date of the offense. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$20.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Driving with an Expired Motor Vehicle Registration** – Defendant remedies the defect not later than the 20<sup>th</sup> working day after the date of the offense OR before the defendant's first court appearance date, whichever is later and defendant establishes that the delinquent registration fee prescribed by Section 502.176 has been paid. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$20.00 dismissal fee. **\*\* HAS NOT BEEN EXPIRED FOR MORE THAN 60 DAYS.**
- ❖ **Fail to Display Registration Insignia on Vehicle** – Passenger car or commercial motor vehicle was issued a registration insignia by the department that establishes that the vehicle was registered for the period and the registration insignia is attached to the passenger car or commercial vehicle before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Failing to Display License Plate on Front and Rear of Vehicle** – Defendant remedies the defect before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Attaching or Displaying a Number Plate or Registration Insignia for Another Registration Period** – Defendant remedies the defect before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Number Plate or Registration Insignia has Letters, Numbers or Other Identification Marks that Are Not Visible at all Times in Daylight** – Defendant remedies the defect before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Number Plate or Registration Insignia has an Attached Illuminated Device, Sticker, Decal, Emblem, or Other Insignia Not Authorized by Law that Interferes with the Readability of the Plate** – Defendant remedies the defect before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Number Plate or Registration Insignia has a Coating, Covering, or Protective Material that Distorts or Alters or Obscures the Numbers, Color or Original Design Features of the Plates** – Defendant remedies the defect before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Driving with an Expired Inspection Certificate** – Defendant remedies the defect not later than the 20<sup>th</sup> working day after the date of the offense OR before the defendant's first court appearance date, whichever is later and the inspection certificate **HAS NOT BEEN EXPIRED FOR MORE THAN 60 DAYS.** The Court **SHALL** dismiss with a \$20.00 dismissal fee.
- ❖ **Allow Vehicle Not Equipped with Required Equipment or Unsafe to be Moved or Driven (NOT APPLICABLE TO CMV)** – Defendant remedies the defect before the defendant's first court appearance. The Court **MAY** dismiss with a \$10.00 dismissal fee. **\*\* VIOLATION MUST BE WORDED AS LISTED HERE.**
