How do I get started?

To get started, register for employment services via the internet by visiting the Work-in-Texas website at www.workintexas.com and complete the online registration. Work-in-Texas will match your skills and experience to the job postings in any area of the state and notify you when a suitable match has been found.

Next, contact your local Texas Veterans Commission Veteran employment services representative to get personal assistance in your job search. Representatives are located at workforce centers. Ask for the Texas Veterans Commission by name.
