JOB ANNOUNCEMENT Designated Representative

Essential Functions:

Responsible for permitting and inspection of On-Site Sewage Facilities (Septic Systems) in accordance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and Waller County rules and regulations.

- 1. Must be familiar with TCEQ OSSF regulations as adopted by Waller County and understanding of Texas Health and Safety codes.
- 2. Advises the public on matters concerning requirements for sewage facilities and rules/regulations within the State and County.
- 3. Assist with permitting-determines when all requirements are satisfactorily met and then issuance of the permit to construct.
- 4. Performs field inspection of each system.
- 5. Investigates sewage violations.
- 6. Attempts to resolve all valid complaints and resolve complaints in an efficient and timely manner.
- 7. Consults with TCEQ staff, as needed.
- 8. Respond to public inquiries in a courteous manner; provide information within the area of assignment.
- 9. Performs related duties as required.
- 10. Assist with weekly meetings and occasionally attend County Commissioners Court.
- 11. Punctual.

Position Specifications:

Requires the following:

- 1. Graduation from High School or a General Education Development (GED) certificate.
- 2. Must have a valid certificate from the State of Texas as an OSSF Designated Representative (DR) or the ability to obtain one within 6 months.
- 3. Must have valid Texas driver's license.
- 4. Computer skills: Outlook, Word, Excel and SAFE Software.
- 5. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships and communication with co-workers, other County employees and elected officials.
- 6. Works well independently in the absence of supervision.
- 7. Able to multi-task, prioritize, and be flexible.

Working Conditions: Field environment; driving from site to site; working closely and courteously with others, exposure to various weather conditions and rough or slick terrain.

Individual Office/Department Conditions: Tasks and special requirements unique to an individual office or department may be addressed through a separate list of detailed specifications prepared by that office/department.
