Essential Functions:

Responsible for a wide variety of clerical work in support of the Engineering Division of the Road and Bridge Department; to include word processing and data entry support; and to provide information and assistance to the public regarding departmental policies and procedures.

- 2. Handle interoffice errands.
- 3. Prepare, type, proofread and process a variety of documents including general correspondence and required reports.
- 4. Performs related duties as required.
- 5. Filing-all Engineering Department correspondence.

- 2. Skill in utilizing personal computers and modern office procedures, methods and computer hardware and software. Microsoft Office proficiency required.

- 4. Must have a valid Texas driver's license.
- 5. Perform varied clerical work and prepare a variety of reports.
- 6. Work well independently in the absence of supervision.
- 7. English usage, spelling, grammar and punctuation.
- 8. Professional attitude and appearance.
