ORDINANCE NO. <u>2021-0211-001</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS, CALLING A BOND ELECTION TO BE HELD WITHIN THE CITY ON MAY 1, 2021; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS INCIDENTAL THERETO.

* * * * * * * * * *

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Prairie View, Texas (the "City") deems it advisable to call the election hereinafter ordered; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that holding the hereinafter called election on the date set forth below is in the public interest; and that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The statements contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of fact and as a part of the operative provisions hereof.

Section 2. Election Called. A bond election shall be held in the City between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on May 1, 2021 (the "Election"), at the designated polling places for residents of the City who reside in Waller County, as set forth in Exhibit A hereto. Exhibit A shall be automatically modified without further action of the Council to include additional or different Election Day polling places designated by the County and/or the Election Administrator, and to conform to the Waller County Election Services Agreement, as applicable; the notices of the Election shall be conformed to such final list.

Section 3. Early Voting Locations and Times. Early voting by personal appearance shall be available for City residents of Waller County at all locations and times established by the Waller County Election Administrator pursuant to the Waller County Election Services Agreement, as set forth in Exhibit B hereto. Exhibit B shall be automatically modified without further action of the Council to include additional or different early voting polling places and times designated by the County, and to conform to the Election Services Agreement; the notices of the

Election shall be conformed to such final lists provided to the City by the County and/or the Election Administrator.

Section 4. Waller County Early Voting Clerk and Application for Ballot. The Early Voting Clerk for voting for the Election shall be Debbie Hollan, Waller County Clerk and Waller County Election Officer. Applications for early voting for all residents of the City should be sent to the following address:

Section 5. Deadline for Applications by Mail or Fax. The last day to submit an application for a ballot to the Early Voting Clerk to be voted by mail (a) by personal delivery is April 14, 2021, and (b) by mail is the close of business on April 21, 2021.

Section 6. Right to Vote. All resident, qualified electors of the City shall be entitled to vote at the Election.

Section 7. Propositions. At the Election, the following propositions shall be submitted in accordance with law:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Prairie View, Texas be authorized to issue and sell one or more series of general obligation bonds of the City in the aggregate principal amount of not more than \$2,500,000.00 for the purpose of making permanent public improvements or other public purposes, to wit: designing, acquiring, constructing, renovating, improving, and equipping City streets, curb, sidewalk, and gutter improvements, demolition, repair, and rebuilding of new and existing streets, completing necessary or incidental utility relocation and drainage and flood control improvements in connection with the foregoing and the purchase of land, easements, rights-of-way, and other real property interests necessary therefor or incidental thereto, such bonds to mature serially or otherwise (not more than forty (40) years from their date) in accordance with law; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of the City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall

not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council of the City be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, within the limitations prescribed by law, on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS PROPOSITION B

"Shall the City Council of the City of Prairie View, Texas be authorized to issue and sell one or more series of general obligation bonds of the City in the aggregate principal amount of not more than \$500,000.00 for the purpose of purchasing new equipment for the police department and making permanent public improvements or other public purposes, to wit: acquiring, constructing, improving, renovating, and equipping public safety facilities, acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto, and completing related landscaping. such bonds to mature serially or otherwise (not more than forty (40) years from their date) in accordance with law; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of the City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council of the City be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, within the limitations prescribed by law, on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS PROPOSITION C

"Shall the City Council of the City of Prairie View, Texas be authorized to issue and sell one or more series of general obligation bonds of the City in the aggregate principal amount of not more than \$1,000,000.00 for the purpose of acquiring, designing, constructing, improving expanding and equipping parks, trails recreational and community centers, such bonds to mature serially or otherwise (not more than forty (40) years from their date) in accordance with law; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of the City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council of the City be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, within the limitations prescribed by law, on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay

the bonds at maturity and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS PROPOSITION D

"Shall the City Council of the City of Prairie View, Texas be authorized to issue and sell one or more series of general obligation bonds of the City in the aggregate principal amount of not more than \$4,000,000.00 for the purpose of acquiring, designing, constructing, improving expanding and installing water and sewer treatment improvements and the acquisition of land and interests in land necessary for said improvements, such bonds to mature serially or otherwise (not more than forty (40) years from their date) in accordance with law; and any issue or series of said bonds to bear interest at such rate or rates (fixed, floating, variable or otherwise) as may be determined within the discretion of the City Council, provided that such rate of interest shall not exceed the maximum rate per annum authorized by law at the time of the issuance of any issue or series of said bonds; and shall the City Council of the City be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, within the limitations prescribed by law, on all taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the annual interest and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds?"

Section 8. Official Ballots. The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Code, so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid propositions which shall be set forth in substantially the following form:

THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,500,000.00 TAX BONDS BY THE CITY OF PRAIRIE VIEW, TEXAS FOR IMPROVING, RENOVATING, UPGRADING AND RECONSTRUCTING TRANSPORTATION AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES IN THE CITY, INCLUDING IMPROVEMENTS TO EXISTING STREETS AND ROADS IN THE CITYAND OTHER RELATED COSTS, THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS THROUGHOUT THE CITY AND VARIOUS TRAFFIC ENHANCEMENTS ALONG MAJOR COLLECTOR AND ARTERIAL ROADWAYS IN THE CITY. TAXES SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS WILL BE IMPOSED.

TAXES SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS WILL BE IMPOSED.

<u>Section 9</u>. Required Information. In accordance with the provisions of Section 3.009(b), Texas Election Code, it is hereby found and determined that:

- (a) The proposition language that will appear on the ballot is set forth in Section 8 hereof.
- (b) The purpose for which the bonds are to be authorized is set forth in Section 7 hereof.
- (c) The principal amount of the bonds to be authorized is set forth in Sections 7 and 8 hereof.
- (d) As set forth in Sections 7 and 8 hereof, if the bonds are approved by the voters, the City Council will be authorized to levy annual ad valorem taxes on all taxable property in the City, sufficient, within the limits prescribed by law, to pay the annual principal of and interest on the bonds and provide a sinking fund to pay the bonds at maturity.
- (e) Based upon the bond market conditions at the date of adoption of this Ordinance, the maximum interest rate for any series of the bonds is estimated to be 5.00% as calculated in accordance with applicable law. Such estimate takes into account a number of factors, including the issuance schedule, maturity schedule and the expected bond ratings of the proposed bonds. Such estimated maximum interest rate is provided as a matter of information but is not a limitation on the interest rate at which the bonds, or any series thereof, may be sold.
- (f) As set forth in Section 7 hereof, if the bonds are approved, they may be issued in one or more series over a period not to exceed 40 years from the date of issuance of each series of bonds.
- (g) The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the City's debt obligations which are secured by ad valorem taxes as of the beginning of the City's 2020-2021 fiscal year is \$4,110,053.00.
- (h) The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest of the City's debt obligations which are secured by ad valorem taxes as of the beginning of the City's 2020-2021 fiscal year is \$2,222,972.00.
- (i) The ad valorem debt service tax rate for the City for the 2020-2021 fiscal year is \$0.15649 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation.
- Section 10. Severability Provision. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of the same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid or unenforceable, neither the remaining portions of this Ordinance nor their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness, invalidity or unenforceability of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable for that purpose.
- Section 11. Effective Date of Ordinance. In accordance with the provisions0 of V.T.C.A., Government Code, Section 1201.028, and Section 3.ll(b) of the Charter of the City, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council on first and final reading.
