Passengers Tires (Off-Rim Only)
Household Chemicals and Cleaners
Pool, Lawn, and Garden Chemicals
Used Auto Oil, Filters, Anti-Freeze, Transmission, and Brake Fluid
Household Batteries
Paints, Stains, and Varnishes (Limit of 25 Gallons per Household)
Fluorescent Light Bulbs
Camp Stove Propane Bottles
Aerosols

Residential Products Labeled "Caution," "Warning," or Poison"

Electronics (i.e., Gaming Devices, Phones, Radios, Laptop/Desktop Computers, Keyboards, Desk Top

Printers/Scanners, and DVD Players)

## **PROHIBITED ITEMS\***

(\*Nb—The County reserves the right to refuse any item)

Industrial, Commercial, or Business Waste
CRT Monitors, TVs in Excess of 36", Floor Standing Copiers, Printers, and Shredders
Water or Fire Damaged Electronic Equipment
Electronic Equipment Previously Stored Outdoors
Tractor of Agriculture Tires
Tires Contaminated with Dirt, Leaves, or Other Debris
Dioxins
Containers in excess of Five (5) Gallons

Containers in excess of Five (5) Gallons
Explosives, Ammunition, or Radioactive Waste
Medical or Pharmaceutical Items
Large Gas or Propane Cylinders
