Deferred disposition may be requested, if you have a good driving record, and you are not currently on deferred disposition. Deferred Disposition means you will be placed on probation for a period of up to 180 days. If you successfully complete the probationary period without receiving a moving violation anywhere in the State of Texas, the original charge will be dismissed.

A deferment cannot be granted, if, the offense occurred in a construction or work zones with workers present, any offense relating to motor vehicle control, other than a parking violation, committed by a person who holds a commercial driver's license (CDL).

Imposed fine and court cost must be paid in full before your probation has ended. Payments may be made in full or with installments over the course of the probation period.

If you are 25 years old or younger, the court shall require you to complete a six hour defensive driving course during the probation period.

I hereby plea no contest, for my traffic citation. I waive my right to jury trial. I have not been granted deferment in the State of Texas within the past twelve months. I understand the Judge may impose a fine be paid during my probation.
