**Deferred disposition** may be requested, if you have a good driving record, and you are not currently on deferred disposition. Deferred Disposition means you will be placed on probation for a period of up to 180 days. If you successfully complete the probationary period without receiving a moving violation anywhere in the State of Texas, the original charge will be dismissed.

**A deferment cannot be granted, if,** the offense occurred in a construction or work zones with workers present, any offense relating to motor vehicle control, other than a parking violation, committed by a person who holds a commercial driver's license (CDL).

**Imposed fine and court cost must be paid in full before your probation has ended.** Payments may be made in full or with installments over the course of the probation period.

**If you are 25 years old or younger,** the court shall require you to complete a six hour defensive driving course during the probation period.

**I hereby plea no contest, for my traffic citation. I waive my right to jury trial. I have not been granted deferment in the State of Texas within the past twelve months. I understand the Judge may impose a fine be paid during my probation.**
