
TEMPORARY STANDING ORDER REGARDING CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) MITIGATION AND ALL JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN WALLER COUNTY (ORDER NO. 14)

Due to coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the four Justices of the Peace of Waller County issue the following order based on the Emergency Orders Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster from the Supreme Court of Texas and the Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas and the COVID-19 Operating Plan for the Waller County Judiciary. This order is issued to protect the community, limit exposure, and provide for an efficient judicial system:

1. Subject only to constitutional limitations a judge may in any civil or criminal case, modify or suspend any and all deadlines and procedures, whether prescribed by statute, rule, or order, for a stated period ending no later than June 1, 2021.
2. No in-person jury trials will be conducted without prior approval and under conditions set forth by the local administrative district judge.
3. All Justice Courts will comply with the COVID-19 Operating Plan for the Waller County Judiciary, issued by Judge Gary Chaney on March 29, 2021.

This order amends and replaces all previous "Temporary Standing Order Regarding Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)" issued by the Justices of the Peace of Waller County.
