
TEMPORARY STANDING ORDER REGARDING CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) MITIGATION AND ALL JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN WALLER COUNTY (ORDER NO. 15)

Due to coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the four Justices of the Peace of Waller County issue the following order based on the Emergency Orders Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster from the Supreme Court of Texas and the Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas and the 506th District Court of the State of Texas. This order is issued to protect the community, limit exposure, and provide for an efficient judicial system:

1. Comply with all orders, as appropriate, from the Supreme Court of Texas.
2. Comply with the COVID-19 Operating Plan for Conducting Jury Trials in Waller County, issued by Judge Gary Chaney on August 31st, 2021, when conducting jury trials.
3. Comply with the COVID-19 Operating Plan for the Waller County Judiciary, issued by Judge Gary Chaney on August 31st, 2021, for normal operations.

This order amends and replaces all previous "Temporary Standing Order Regarding Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)" issued by the Justices of the Peace of Waller County.
