**APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION.** Hempstead Yogi, Ltd., 213 North Friendswood Drive, Friendswood, Texas 77546, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a new permit, TCEQ Permit No. WQ0015640001 to authorize the disposal of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 30,000 gallons per day via surface irrigation of 7.68 acres of non-public access pastureland. The draft permit authorizes the disposal of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 15,000 gallons per day via surface irrigation of 7.68 acres of non-public access pastureland. This permit will not authorize a discharge of pollutants into water in the state. TCEQ received this application on January 8, 2018.

The wastewater treatment facility and disposal site will be located at 34843 Betka Road, in Waller County, Texas 77484. The wastewater treatment facility and disposal site will be located in the drainage basin of Brazos River Below Navasota River in Segment No. 1202 of the Brazos River Basin. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at the Waller County Library, 2331 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Hempstead, Texas.

**PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING.** You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ holds a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.
