NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION FOR TPDES PERMIT FOR MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER RENEWAL

PERMIT NO. WQ0014944001

APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. Royal Wailea Investment, LP, 2047 Westcreek Lane, Suite 1303, Houston, Texas 77027, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0014944001, which authorizes the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 1,500,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on January 9, 2019.

The facility will be located approximately 1 mile northeast of the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 362 and Stockdick Road, in Waller County, Texas 77423. The treated effluent will be discharged to an unnamed ditch, thence to Brookshire Creek, thence to Bessies Creek, thence to the Brazos River Below Navasota River in Segment No. 1202 of the Brazos River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is minimal aquatic life use for unnamed ditch. The designated uses for Segment No. 1202 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Brookshire Pattison Library, 3815 6th Street, Brookshire, Texas.

TCEQ holds a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.
