### NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION FOR TPDES PERMIT FOR MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER

**APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION.** Fulshear Municipal Utility District No. 3B, 9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0015443001 which authorizes the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at a daily average flow not to exceed 960,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on December 17, 2019.

The facility is located approximately 1.46 miles southeast of the intersection of Interstate Highway 10 and Woods Road, in Waller County, Texas 77423. The treated effluent is discharged to a drainage ditch, thence to detention ponds, thence to a drainage ditch, thence to Willow Fork Buffalo Bayou, thence to Buffalo Bayou, thence to Buffalo Bayou Above Tidal in Segment No. 1014 of the San Jacinto River Basin. The unclassified receiving water uses are minimal aquatic life use for both drainage ditches and limited aquatic life use for the detention pond. The designated uses for Segment No. 1014 are primary contact recreation and limited aquatic life use. All determinations are preliminary and subject to additional review and/or revisions. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements.
