***Please note:** There are no entries fees for this show. The quilts will be judged by dignitaries of Waller County, not quilting experts. One winner for each category, as well as a viewer's choice award will be recognized.

Preparing your quilt for entry:

All entries should have a fabric label attached to the bottom left hand corner on the back of the item. The label should contain the name of the quilt and your name.

The quilt should have a hanging sleeve that has either been stitched or safety pinned (no straight pins) to the top of the edge of the quilt. (Note: if your quilt is longer than 80" please place the hanging sleeve at 80" or pin up the bottom of the quilt so it will not touch the floor.)

A copy of the entry form should be attached to the quilt's protective case. Please place your quilt in a cloth bag, such as a pillowcase so that it will be protected before the show and returned to you in that bag after the show.

Submitting your Quilt to the Sesquicentennial Show:

Quilts should be brought to the Barbara Carpenter building at the Waller County Fairgrounds on **Thursday, April 27th from 5pm to 7pm.** Quilts will be hung Friday morning and judged Friday afternoon. Your Quilt will be ready for you to pick up on **Sunday, April 30th from 12pm to 2pm.**

I grant permission for the Waller County Sesquicentennial Committee to display photographs of my quilt. I understand that every effort will be made to safeguard all quilts entered; however, the Waller County Sesquicentennial Committee or any of its helpers are not liable for loss or damage to quilts. Insurance coverage will not be provided by the Waller County Sesquicentennial Committee. Insurance coverage is the sole responsibility of the entrant.
