





(Above) WCRB uses CPM scheduling to ensure projects are delivered on time and within budget.




Local Govt Code §232.0025 (c): A [plat] application is considered complete when all documentation [is received].


Local Govt Code §232.0025 (d): [the commissioners court] shall approve, approve with conditions, or disapprove a plat application not later than the 30th day after the date the completed application is received by the commissioners court or the court's designee.



On average, 2 review days are lost for each external review due to the transmittal process (ie~forwarding documents between consultant and applicant, etc.)

Our strategy is to move more reviews internal to achieve compliance with Local Government Code 232.






With the addition of another Engineering Tech and an Assistant County Engineer, we will be able to double our current plan review staff.




