To Whom It May Concern:

Waller County does not issue Certificates of Occupancy in any circumstance.

Waller County does not enforce zoning in the unincorporated areas.

Based on the Waller County Subdivision and Development Regulations, residential development within unincorporated areas of Waller County requires permits to be obtained, which include: a development permit, a driveway permit and a septic permit. A certificate of compliance is required following approval of the Infrastructure Development Plan for rental communities.

Additionally, Waller County does not enforce building codes for the construction of single/multifamily residential, commercial, or public buildings at this time.
