**EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF
LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, beginning in December, 2019, a novel coronavirus, now designated as COVID-19, was detected in mainland China, and has since spread throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, the world Health Organization declared COVID-19 a worldwide pandemic on March 11th, 2020; and


WHEREAS, extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Waller County; and

WHEREAS, the Waller County Judge issued a Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic on March 18, 2020;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. The disaster declaration is extended for Waller County, Texas, pursuant to Section 418.108 (b) of the Texas Government Code.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue until terminated by the Commissioners Court of the County of Waller, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.




