

Due to growing concerns of potential COVID-19 contamination the Waller County Recycling Center will be implementing some temporary policies:

1. Customers will be responsible for unloading and handling of their recyclables. If the items are in bins the bin will be emptied into one of our trash cans and from there staff will empty that into the compactor. Large items like cardboard can go straight into the compactor.
2. Robin and I (Brian) will maintain social distancing from customers but we will also monitor what is being dropped off. As many know we don't take everything here and we're often left with some trash by customers. . Any loads that do not meet requirements will be rejected.
3. These rules also apply to any volunteers and community service workers. We will be sure to talk to them and make sure they're not visibly sick and monitor their hygiene.

We are implementing these policies because Robin and I see sometimes hundreds of people a day they're bringing waste that has been in contact with who knows how many people and there's multiple surfaces we have to come in contact with. We are both in a situation where we have family that are at risk of this virus being fatal so we want to try our best to help people without putting ourselves at unnecessary risk. We will do our best to help people that are disabled but we are asking everyone that comes to handle their recyclables as much as they can and we appreciate your cooperation.
