NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION AND INTENT TO OBTAIN WATER QUALITY PERMIT

PROPOSED PERMIT NO. WQ0016562001

APPLICATION. Century Communities, Inc., 333 Cypress Run, Suite 200, Houston, Texas 77094, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for proposed Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0016562001 (EPA I.D. No. TX0146226) to authorize the discharge of treated wastewater at a volume not to exceed a daily average flow of 720,000 gallons per day. The domestic wastewater treatment facility will be located approximately 0.14 miles west-northwest of the intersection of Falcon Drive and Farm-to-Market Road 529, near the city of Brookshire, in Waller County, Texas 77423. The discharge route will be from the plant site via storm sewer to unnamed ditch; thence to Brookshire Creek; thence to Bessies Creek; thence to Brazos River Below Navasota River. TCEQ received this application on June 21, 2024. The permit application will be available for viewing and copying at Waller County Library - Brookshire Pattison Library, Front Desk, 3815 6th Street, Brookshire, Texas prior to the date this notice is published in the newspaper. TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public
