### NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION FOR TPDES PERMIT FOR MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER

#### RENEWAL

**PERMIT NO. WQ0010024006**

**APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION.** City of College Station, P.O. Box 9960, College Station, Texas 77842, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0010024006, which authorizes the discharge of treated domestic wastewater at an annual average flow not to exceed 9,500,000 gallons per day. TCEQ received this application on May 2, 2024.

The facility is located at 2200 North Forest Parkway, in the City of College Station, in Brazos County, Texas 77845. The treated effluent is discharged to Carters Creek, thence to Navasota River Below Lake Limestone in Segment No. 1209 of the Brazos River Basin. The unclassified receiving water use is intermediate aquatic life use for Carters Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 1209 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use. The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements.
