Procedures for VTR-68a Inspections

Inspections are conducted every Wednesday by <u>APPOINTMENT ONLY</u>. Inspections are subject to weather and personnel availability. To request an appointment please read instructions below.

VTR-68a Vehicle Inspections: The Waller County Sheriff's Office conducts inspections for residents who reside in Waller County <u>only</u>. The cost is \$40 per vehicle inspection. Payment can be made with cash, money order, or cashier's check. Personal checks and credit/debit cards are not accepted.

The vehicle MUST be "ROAD READY". Inspections will not be conducted on partially assembled vehicles.

Reasons for VTR-68a:

- Vehicle is being imported from another country
- Vehicle is missing the VIN plate
- Assembled vehicles
- Homemade Trailers
- Any other reason the Department of Motor Vehicle has told you that you need to provide a VTR-68a.

For all inspections you must bring:

- The vehicle
- DL/ Identification
- Insurance
- Safety Inspection
- Proof of purchase/ Bill of Sale
- Title and other documents you may have for the vehicle that may be necessary.
- Homemade Trailers must have all documentation showing how the trailer was built and where the materials came from. You must provide pictures of the trailer that show the building process from start to finish. A trailer cannot be registered as a homemade trailer for the reason the original paperwork for the manufactured trailer was lost or is missing.

Bonded Titles:

Inspections will be conducted on vehicles with Bonded Titles not currently registered in Texas. To make an appointment, please send an email to b.fausset@wallercounty.us or call 979-826-8282 and ask to speak with Detective Byron Fausset.
